Where do I go?

We look forward to seeing you at 6:15pm on July 10th at Full Life Church: 2510 East Cherokee Drive. All Campers will check-in and pick up at the front of the building (under the awning).

Registration/Check-In

Each night, the camper will need to Check-In at the registration table. Check-In will be from **6:15-6:30pm for all campers.** As you can imagine, this can get a little hectic the first night of camp as we will be double-checking participant information. There are a few things you can do on the first night to help us:

- 1. Check-In begins at 6:15pm, so come a little early to avoid the 6:30 rush. This is especially true on the first night of camp as we double check emergency information.
- 2. If your student has special concerns, please be prepared to share that with us. This is especially for students who have allergies/asthma. A nurse will be onsite every night to address any issues that might arise.
- 3. Make sure to grab your pick-up tag!

Pick Up

The first night at camp, you will receive a pick-up tag that has your child's name, and activity. In order for us to release your child(ren) to you, we will need that tag. This is simply a safety precaution to ensure that children aren't released to an adult that they are not permitted to be with. Check out/Pick up is from **8:45-9:00pm** for all campers.

<u>Snacks</u>

Each night, students will receive a snack and water. We will not have any snacks that include nuts. If your student has a specific *food allergy*, please make sure we know. Also, please come prepared with an alternative snack. (Exception: Cooking Campers may eat the goodies they prepare in class)

Format

The format is the same each night. Each night officially begins at 6:30pm and ends at 8:45pm.

- Opening Rally: We get our bodies warmed up with stretches and dancing. We sing and play silly games.
- Session 1
- Halftime Huddle: A cool-down time, snack, and short discussion time conducted by our huddle coaches.
- Session 2
- Closing Rally: Includes an interactive Bible lesson and a few more silly games to end the night.

What to Bring

ALL campers should bring a water bottle with their name on it. MEGA will be having a Coin Drive to benefit Operation Christmas Child, so bring a handful of coins to support this non-profit.
