# **MEGA Sports and Art Camp**

## **When is MEGA?**

Mega Sports and Art Camp will be held the week of July 11-15. The big finale is our MEGA Sunday Rally, held on Sunday, July 17th during the 11:15am service.

## **What is MEGA?**

Full Life Church offers kids, PreK through fifth grade, one awesome week, July 11 – 15 & 17, 2022. We want to give kids the chance to learn more about sports and art; BUT that's not all! Our campers will also enjoy upbeat rallies filled with energetic praise and worship music, fun sports stories, ultra cool visual learning experiences, and Bible stories that will help them discover character traits that can help them excel in sports and in life.

This is the biggest outreach that our church does to reach our community. This year we will be offering Sports Basics, Cheer, Basketball, Flag Football, Volleyball, Cooking, & Canvas Painting.

## **Set-up Sunday**

Sunday, July 10 is set up day. We will begin at the end of 2nd service.

## **What does a night at camp look like?**

### **Nightly Format**

- Check-In: Each night campers check in from 6:15 to 6:30pm
- Opening Rally: We get our bodies warmed up with stretches, games and dancing.
- Session 1: Sport/Art Session
- Halftime Huddle: A cool-down time, snack, and short discussion time conducted by huddle coaches.
- Session 2: Sport/Art Session
- Closing Rally: Includes an interactive Bible lesson and a few more silly games to end the night.
- Camper Pick-Up: Parents bring their pickup tag to sanctuary door and camper is called for pick up (8:45 to 9:00pm).

# What areas are available to volunteers?

## Volunteer Roles and General Responsibilities

### Coach

- Provides instruction during sports sessions
- Main leader of group (provide structure, organization, and *fun*)
- Keeping group together (accounted for) at all times

### Huddle Coach

- Provides ministry time for group
- Support head coach when needed
- Maintain attendance each night

### Sports Helper

- Follow lead of head coach and huddle coach to ensure kids are engaged
- Encourage team-work and *fun*

### Snack Team

- Provide snack and water to each group at 7:15pm each night
- Clean water pitchers and prepare for next day

### Registration Team

- Ensure parents and children have a pleasant drop-off experience (*smile*)
- Check kids in each night, provide name tag and event bracelet

### Dinner Team

- Set up Volunteer Dinner (served nightly at 5:30)

### Set up/Equipment Team

- Fill up water stations each night, double check equipment is in correct locations

### Volunteer Kid Care Team

- Provide pre-planned activities to help kids ages 0-3 have a safe and fun night

### Special Projects Team

- For those who can only serve one or two nights: special projects such as notes of encouragement, stuffing candy bags, and other nightly tasks.

## **Volunteer Information:**

### **Training**

There will be an “All Volunteer” Meeting at the church, 2 weeks prior to camp, where we review camp guidelines and answer any lingering questions. There are 2 dates available to make sure you can attend one.

### **Background Checks**

We promise a safe environment for all children and ask that a background check be performed on ALL volunteers at MEGA. We are using an online system for background checks. Once you register on Church Center to volunteer, you should receive an email with a link for the background check. If you have not, please see Josh Aguilar.

### **Volunteer Check-in & End of Night**

Dinner will be available for all volunteers and their children every evening behind the stage beginning at 5:30. Volunteer check-in will be in the *FOYER*. All volunteers must check-in, please wear your camp shirt and lanyard. Campers coming with a volunteer will be checked in at the same time as the volunteer in the *FOYER*. We will have a meeting and a gift card give-away each night promptly at 6PM. You must be in the sanctuary to win. Please stay until camp is over and help us get the building ready for the next night.

### **Pray**

Please be in prayer throughout the next few weeks that God touches each child and family that will be attending Mega Sports and Art Camp.

### **Event Parking**

Volunteers are asked to park on either the far left or far right spaces in parking lot each night. Please do not park in front of the building or under the awing (with exception of those that need to use handicap parking).

### **Volunteers' Children**

If you choose to volunteer, your children that are PreK - 5<sup>th</sup> grade will be able to register early for camp on June 11<sup>th</sup>. Children of volunteers ages birth - 3, can be registered for Volunteer Kid Care. Our Volunteer Kid Care team will make sure our youngest are loved and have a fun week at MEGA.
